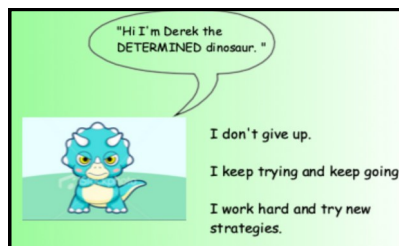
Learning Behaviours

Next week, our character will be Derek the Determined Dinosaur.

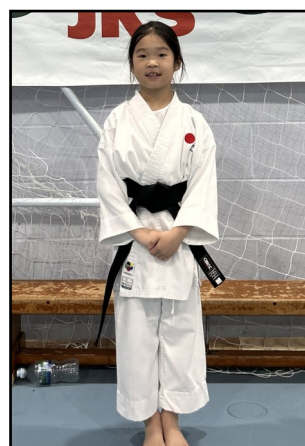
Encourage your child to practise the skills listed below and be like Derek.

Book Fair

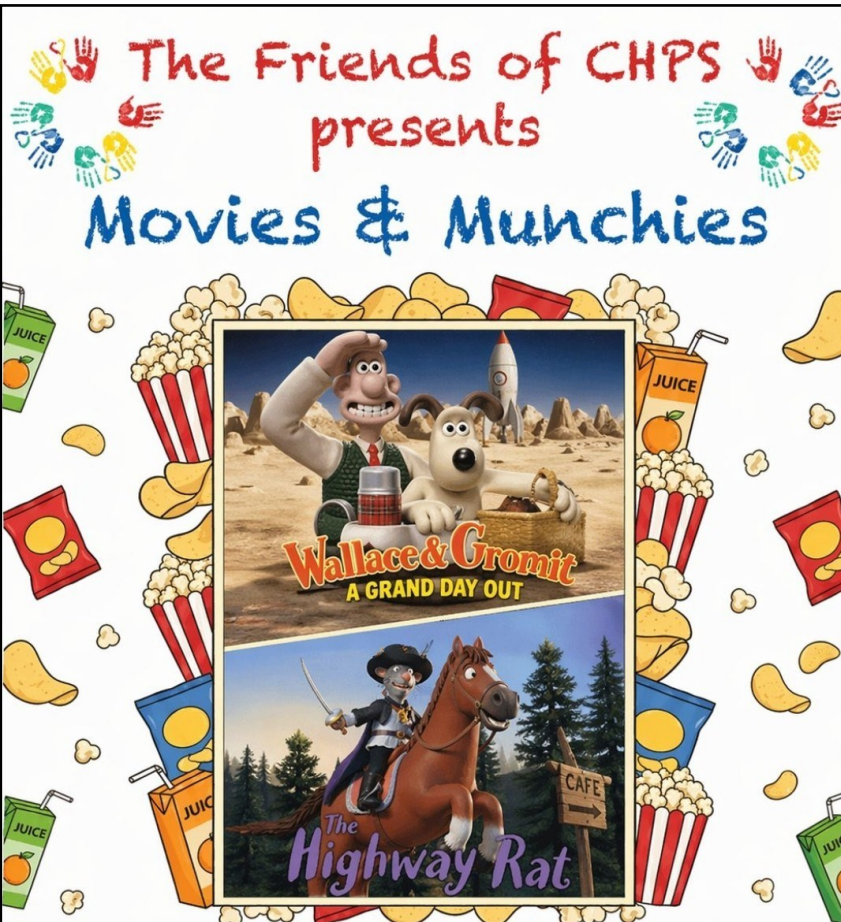
