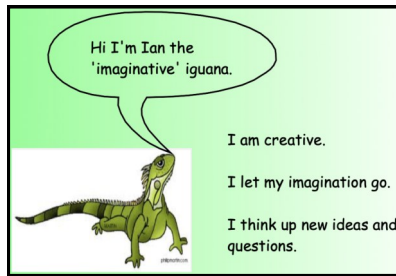

## Computing

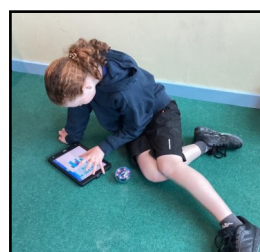
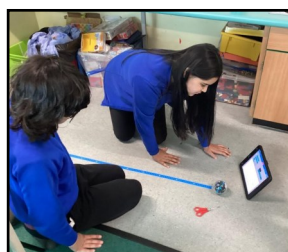
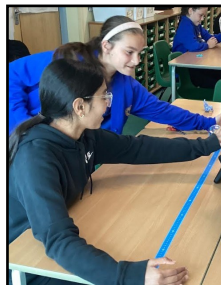
