Breakfast and after school clubs will all start week commencing 14th September

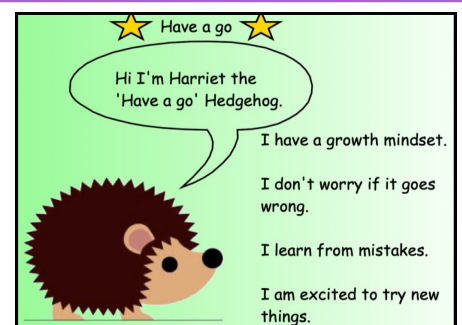
Learning Behaviours
