Online Safety Byte

You could set some family rules (for everyone to follow) around device rules such as screen time limits, and tech free spaces. Involving your child in creating this agreement makes them more likely to stick to it. Here are some instructions on how to use parental controls on your child's iPhone or iPad.



Set Content & Privacy Restrictions 1. Go to Settings and tap Screen Time.

- Tap Turn on Screen Time, then tap it again. Choose "This is My [Device]" or "This is My Child's [Device]" 2.
- 3. To set up Screen Time on your child's device, follow the prompts until you get to Screen Time Passcode and enter a passcode. Re-enter the passcode to confirm. After you've confirmed your passcode you'll be asked to enter your Apple ID and password. This can be used to reset your Screen Time passcode if you forget it.
