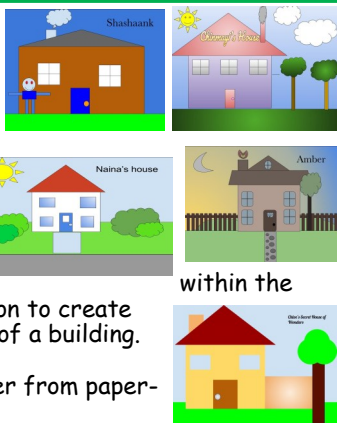
If you want to discuss any wellbeing concerns Ms Squires is available as our Learning mentor for you to contact.

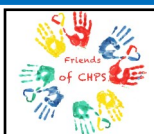
