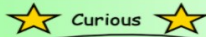


Learning Behaviours

I ask questions and research topics.

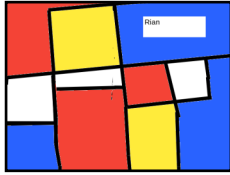

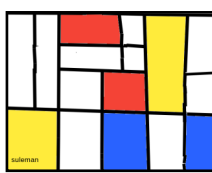
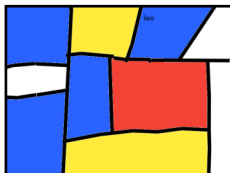
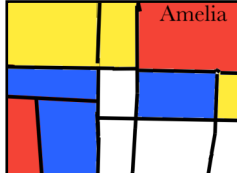
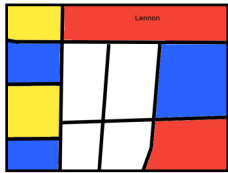


Considerate Parking
