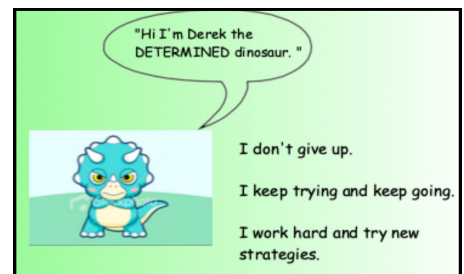

Digital Leaders

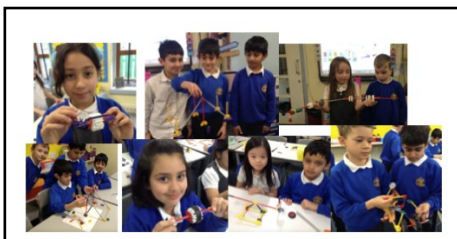

Online Safety Byte

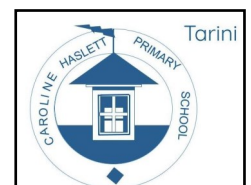
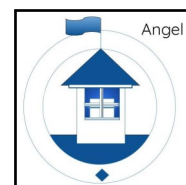
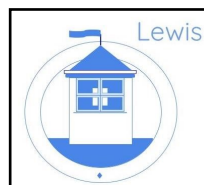
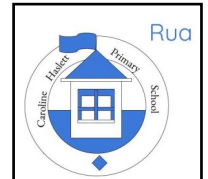
Caroline Haslett will be celebrating Safer Internet Day on Wednesday 8th February. We will be having a House Swap morning and afternoon assemblies.
