Wellbeing Cafe

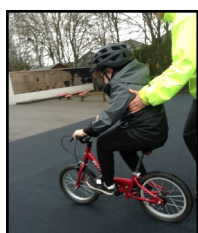
The next wellbeing cafe will be on **Friday 28th April**, and our community PCSO's will be joining us to talk about 'Keeping safe in the community and outside school'.

They learnt all about the 5 food groups, and how we can easily keep track of what we eat and how we exercise. The children really enjoyed it and learnt a lot.

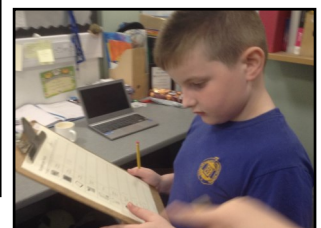
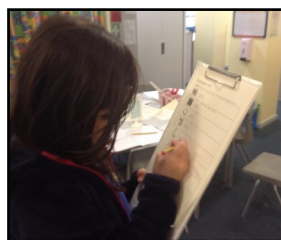
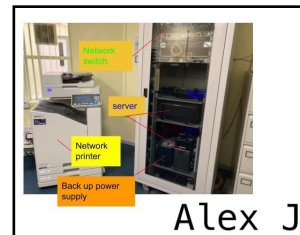

UK-wide test of an emergency alert system Sunday 23rd April

If you're living with domestic abuse and you have a mobile phone hidden in your house "just in case", please remember to switch it off on 22nd April and keep it switched off until the 24th.

On 23rd April, a UK-wide test of an emergency alert system will take place on every mobile phone in the country. This loud alarm will sound on your phone even if it is switched to silent or notifications are off.

Your hidden phone needs to be switched off completely during this time to avoid discovery.
