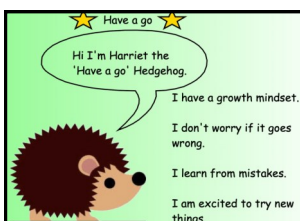


## Learning Behaviours

Naomika from Winstanley class has completed her level IV in Art Education.

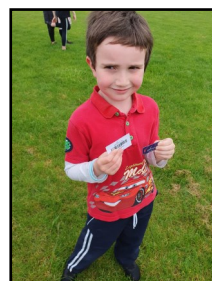
Well done Naomika!

- Raffle Prizes

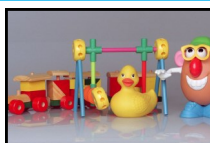
These can be dropped into the school office.
