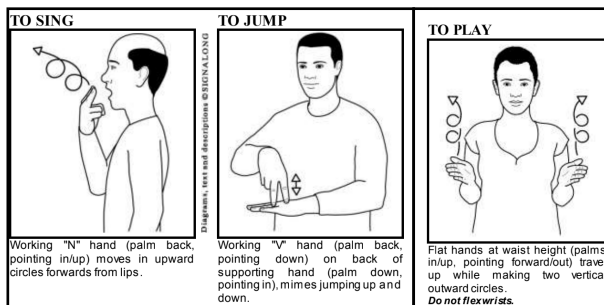

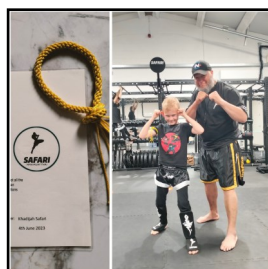

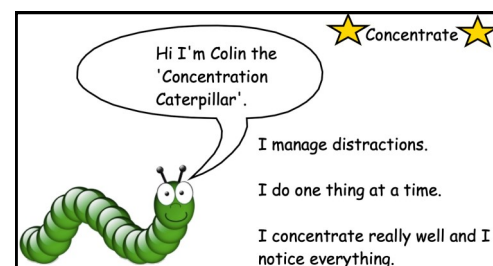

I concentrate really well and I notice everything.

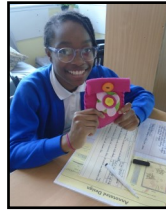
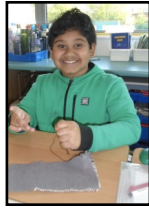
