
Wellbeing Cafe

Learning Behaviours


At Caroline Haslett Primary School, we have 8 characters that help us remember the skills of an effective learner in all of our lessons.

The children gained a Discover Arts award and celebrated an ancient




Sponge the Teacher seemed to be a massive hit and will certainly be back again. Mr Ruth-
