There will be no clubs or music tuition in the last week of term.

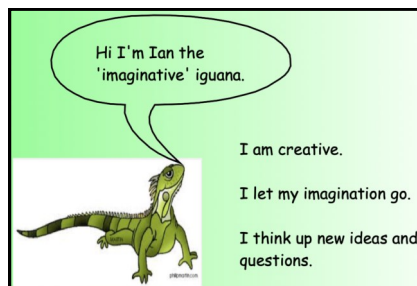

The character next week will be Ian the Imaginative Iguana. Encourage your child to practise the skills listed below and be like Ian.

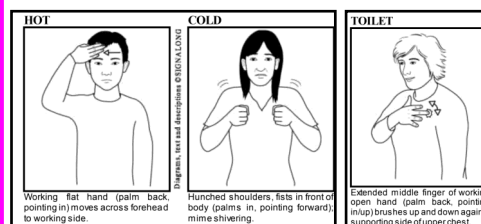

## Jazz Assembly

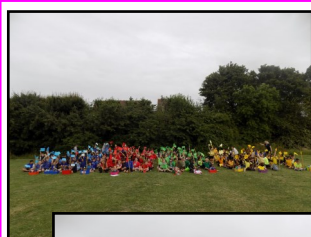
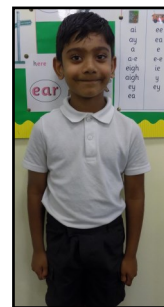

Good work Kaniishk!



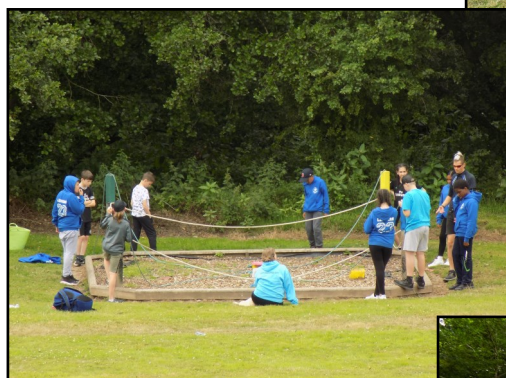
## Sports Day 2023

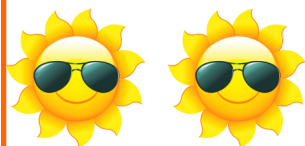

The total raised was even higher than we told you last week - **Final figures take it to an amazing £3077.39.**

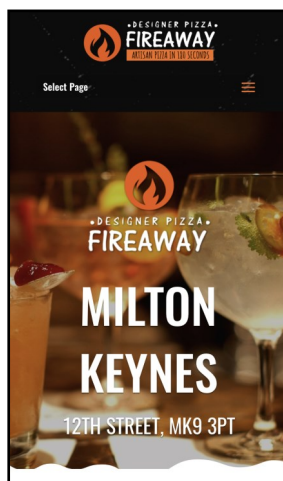


This will be used to provide playground markings on the new playground installed this year.
