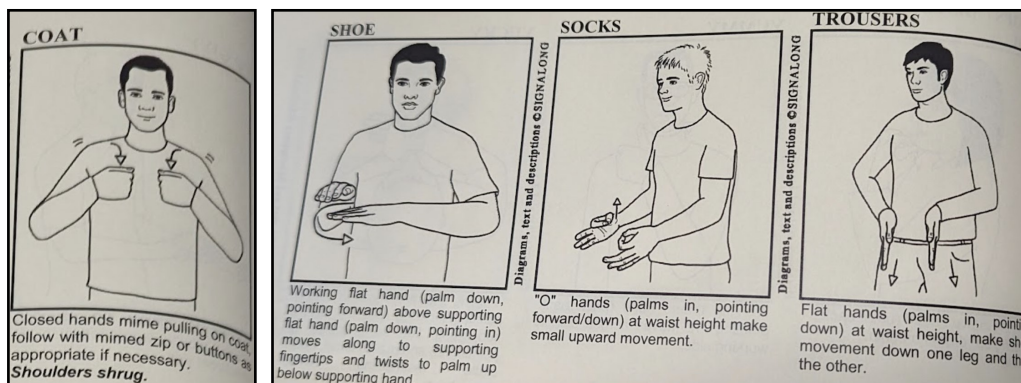
Signs of the Week

- Trousers



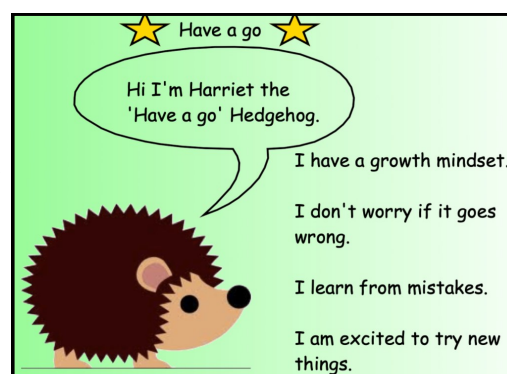
