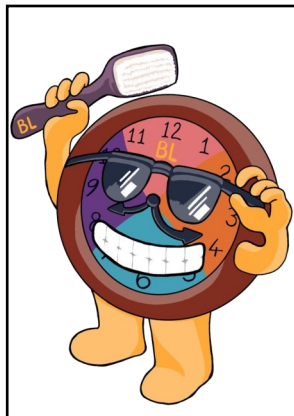
## Online Safety Byte

Clockwise reminds us to use technology responsibly.

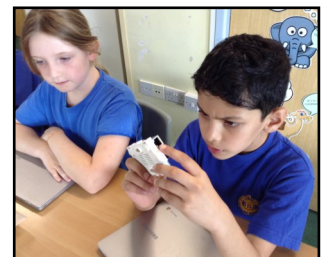
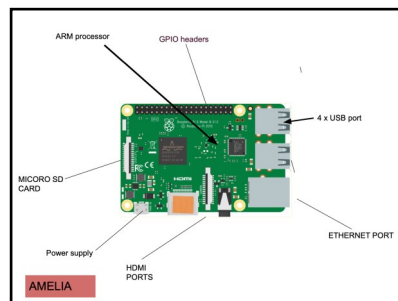
He has a clockface to remind us about time limits and schedules for our devices.

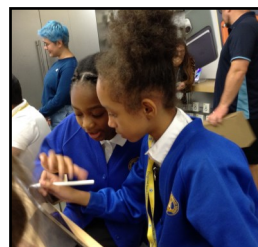
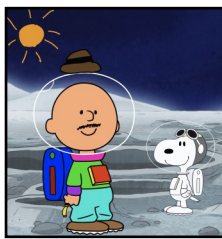
## Computing
