He attained 7 grade 9s, 2 grade 8s and a Distinction double star.

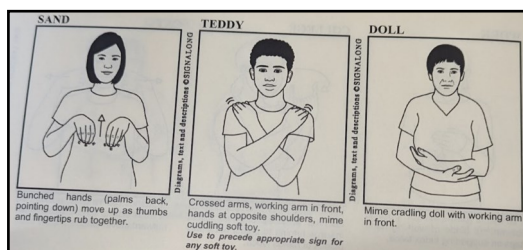

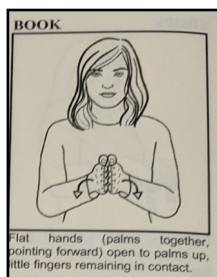

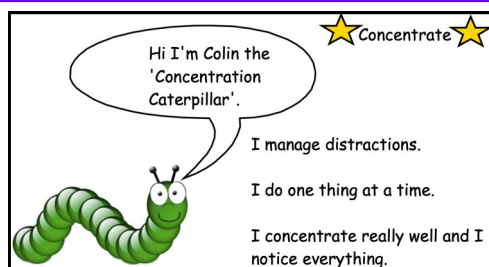


## Learning Behaviours

## Computing

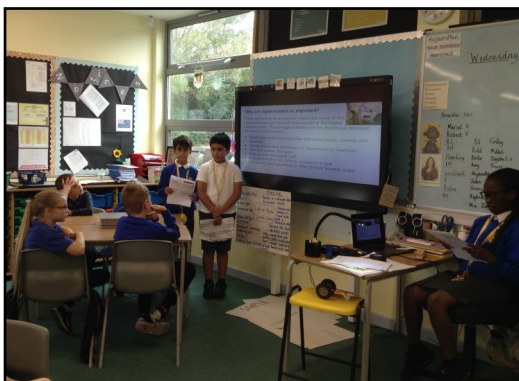
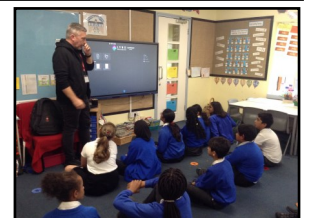
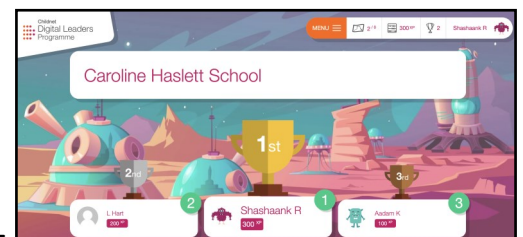
Year 1 are enjoying the start of their Computing journey through using the iPads.

## Digital Leaders

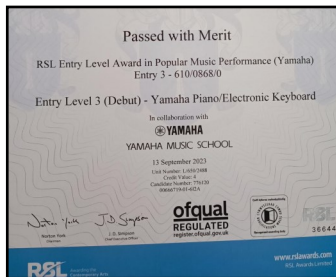
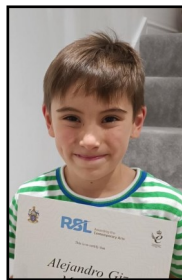
