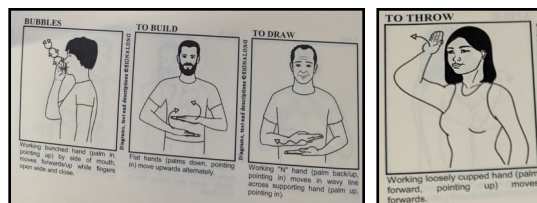

the Flu Vaccinations to all children.

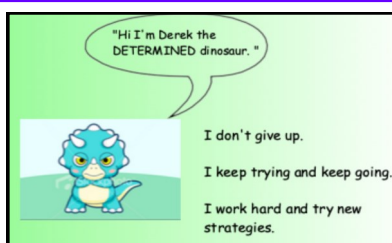

Gymnastics


The year 3 & 4 boys' gymnastics team went to Bushfield school on Friday.

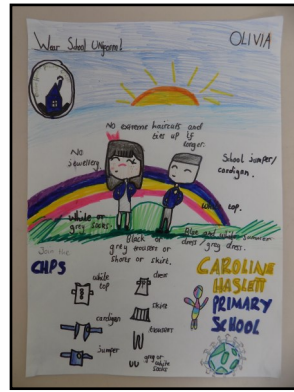


Social Impact Award

The netball "B" team travelled to Christ the Sower school on Thursday afternoon.

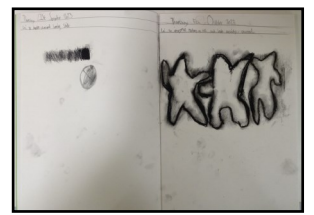
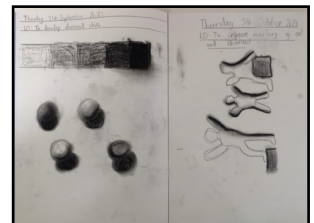
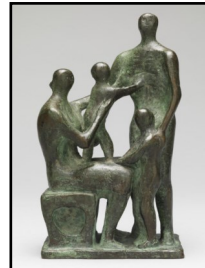
They played really well and gained a lot of confidence whilst playing. They came away with a 6-2 win.
