Caroline Haslett joined up with the MK Food Bank and other companies and schools on Monday in an attempt to smash the current World Record for the longest line of cans of food.

The World Record attempt took place on World Food Day, Monday 16th October, in and around Campbell Park. The local charity was aiming for an ambitious target of 132,000 cans over a

10km line and encouraged schools and businesses across Milton Keynes to help them achieve this.

The route was divided into 25 metre-long sections, and businesses, schools, local councils and community groups all signed up to help.

As a school we were asked to provide 320 cans and we ended up with 445! With this massive number we helped out lots of other teams and after the final count was done, the record was broken!








Pupil Achievement


Happy News Competition

He is very proud of his Competitor's Medal!
















First Disco of the new school year was a HIT!
