remember the skills of an effective learner in all of our lessons.

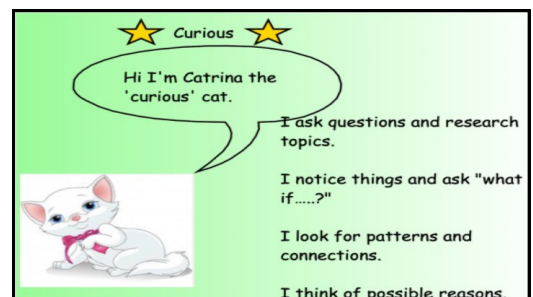
Next week's character will be Catrina the Curious Cat. Encourage your
