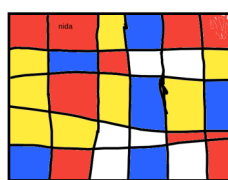
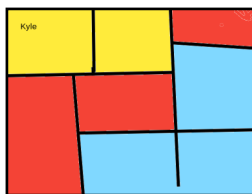
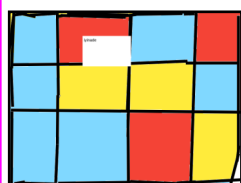
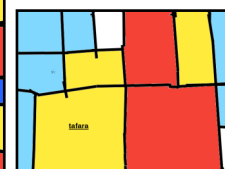
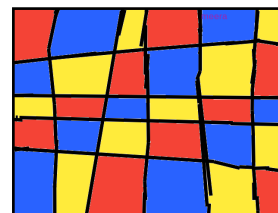
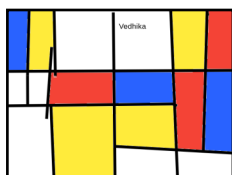
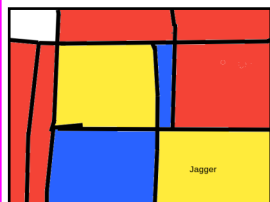
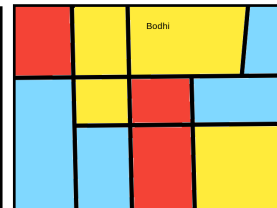
## Assembly
