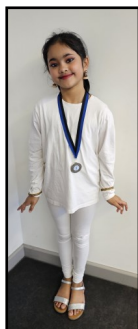

## Pupil Achievement

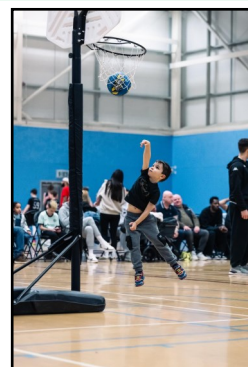
