## Computing

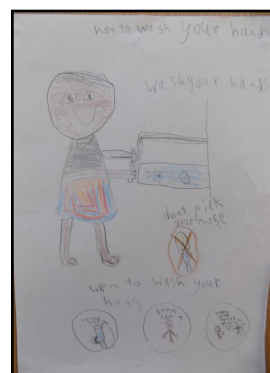
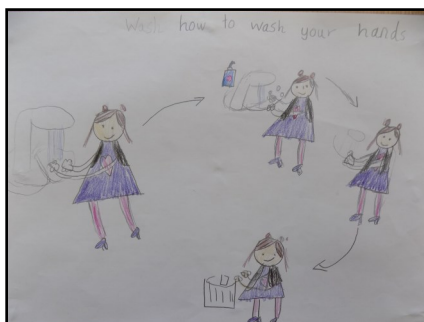

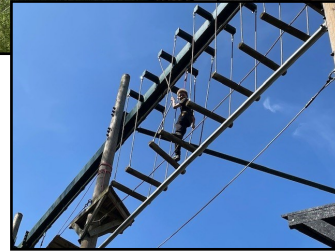
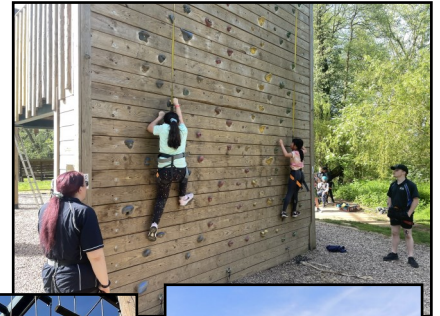


## Health & Wellbeing Committee

## Year 2

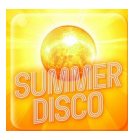
