Singing at St Mary's

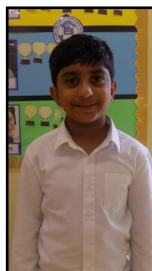
This week, the children in Rutherford class, and the Year 5/6 choir, visited St Mary's Church in Shenley Church End to participate in a fun singing session.

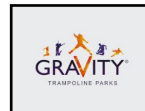
