The United Kingdom (UK) is made up of 4 countries:

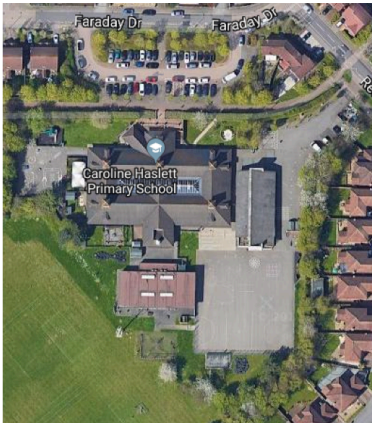
- England

### Vocabulary

**Aerial view** - a view from the air.

**Location** - where something is.

**Map** - the aerial view of a place.

**Route** - the way taken to get from one place to another.



### Skills

- Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries.
- Use simple locational and directional language [for example, near and far; left and right], to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
- Interpret and follow a route on a map.
- Use geographical vocabulary to refer to physical and human features.

<b>Location Knowledge</b>	Name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries of the United Kingdom.
<b>Place knowledge</b>	Understand the human and physical geography of the area of the school.
<b>Human and physical</b>	Know basic geographical vocabulary to refer to key physical and human features eg. trees, playground, field, car park, school, houses, redway.
<b>Geographical skills and fieldwork</b>	Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries. Use aerial photographs to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features. Use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of the school and its grounds [interpreting and following a map route, identifying features]. Use simple locational and directional language [eg. near and far, left and right] to describe the location of features and routes on a map.
