Atlas - a book of maps.

Continent - the world's main continuous expanses of land.

Globe - a 3d representation of the Earth.

Map - the aerial view of a place.

Ocean - a large body of salt water, which covers the majority of the earth's surface.

Sea - a part of the ocean that is enclosed, or partly enclosed, by land.
