Useful vocabulary

Bully/ bullying - Someone who is unkind to someone else more than once
Deliberate - When something is done on purpose
Friends - Someone who you play with and can trust
Emergency - When someone is at risk of harm and needs help
Hazard - Something that could be unsafe and cause an accident
Dangerous - Something that could seriously harm you
Safe - Something that will not hurt you in any way
Prevent - A way to stop something dangerous from happening

Activities

- Making a 'wanted' poster for a friend.
- Thought shower what makes a good friend
- Give and receive compliments (whole class activity)
- Read story about falling out and role play how to solve the problem
- Thought shower about why we fall out.
- Blow up a balloon to illustrate how anger triggers can get out of control
- Draw yourself, show how anger might feel and what it looks like in you.
- Discuss what makes us angry.
- Link to Anti-Bullying week assembly
- Awards for good friend, being kind to someone and refusing to join in with unkind behaviour.
- Invite fire officer to school to discuss about keeping safe. Local visitor about road safety
- Make a poster about fire safety/ road safety
- Role play an emergency/ calling 999/ crossing the road

Skills

- Take part in discussions with one other person and the whole class, and take part in a simple debate about topical issues

- Recognise the choices they make and recognise the difference between right and wrong.
