<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know how to avoid opponents • Understand the role of an attacker • Understand the role of a defender • Understand when to pass 	<p>Attacker A player - in the row nearest to the opposing team's goal - who is mainly responsible for scoring goals.</p> <p>Defender A player whose main role is to stop attackers during the game and prevent the opposing team from scoring goals.</p> <p>Tackle - Take the ball from your opponent by using the feet</p>
