<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Know the best place to stand to receive a ball</li> <li>• Know how to make a game harder for opponents</li> <li>• Understand attacking and defensive play</li> </ul>	<p><b>Attacking</b> - the team with the ball and has the opportunity to score a try</p> <p><b>1v1</b> - one attacker and one defender in a small game</p> <p><b>2v1</b> - two attackers and one defender</p> <p><b>Switch pass</b> - the ball is passed behind to a team member who changes the direction quickly to confuse the defending team</p> <p><b>Arrow formation</b> - attacking team to start in an arrow formation so the ball can be pass easily and quickly</p>
