Congratulations Ayla!

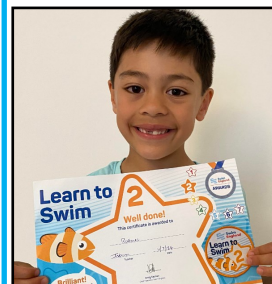


Pupil Achievement

Pupil Achievement

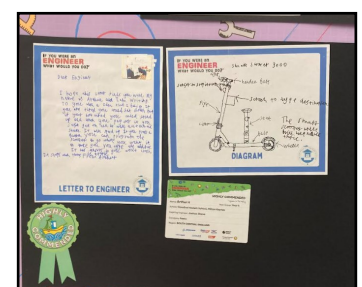

The panel of judges praised Arthur for his traffic reducing self-driving Smart Scooter 3000 which could be electric or human-powered, includes a seat "in case you need a rest", sensors to stop crashes and a SAT nav to get you to your destination.

The exhibition showcased other remarkable designs from talented young engineers. Notable among them were Ismail, Ayla and Dominic, whose projects were also shortlisted for distinction.

Arthur was presented with a framed certificate and a badge, marking his achievement and recognising his contribution to engineering innovation.
