Here are the signs for this week:

<p>CARROT</p> <p>As in: CARROT</p> <p>Working flat (palm forward, pointing up) beside mouth, wrist to palm down, pointing forward.</p> <p>Sign Image: </p>	<p>CHEESE</p> <p>As in: CHEESE</p> <p>Fingertips of working hand (palm down, pointing forward) rest on supporting flat hand (palm up, pointing forward).</p> <p>Sign Image: </p>	<p>CHIPS</p> <p>As in: CHIPS</p> <p>Open pinched hands (palm in, pointing forward), hands move a little apart, indexes closing on to thumbs. Repeat.</p> <p>Sign Image: </p>	<p>MILK</p> <p>As in: MILK</p> <p>Flat 'C' hands (palm in, pointing forward) move up and down alternately with gentle spacing action. 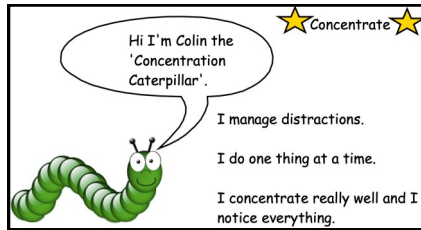


Learning Behaviours

Please do not bring dogs on site when you are dropping off or collecting your child from school.

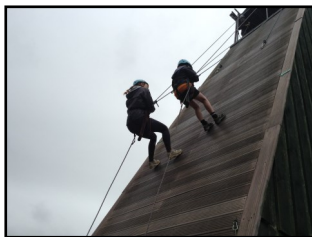
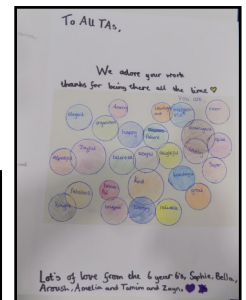
Reminder
