Ainaakshi from Murrey class has passed her stage 3 in swimming and has now moved onto stage 4.

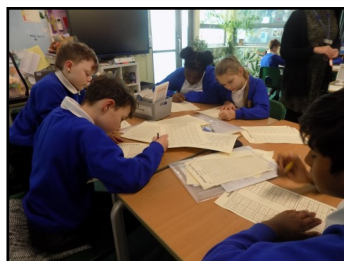
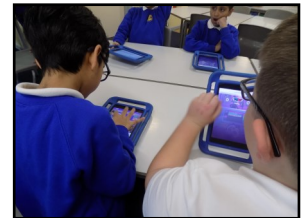

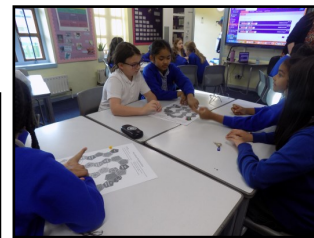
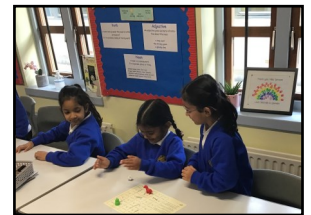


Maths Week

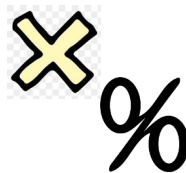
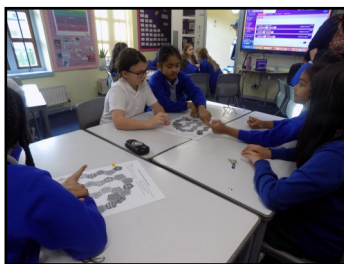
