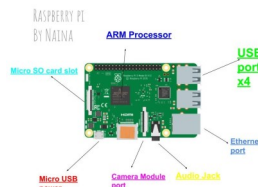

This week's Caroline Haslett Online Safety Hero is Raptious Reporter.

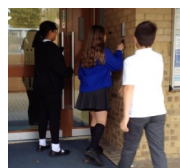

Well done to all three of them in their amazing achievements and best of luck in the World Championships!

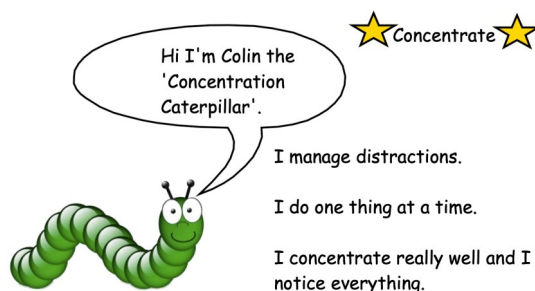


Learning Behaviours
