Polite Notice

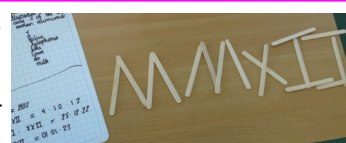
Medicines should be handed into the school office. They should not be put into children's school bags.

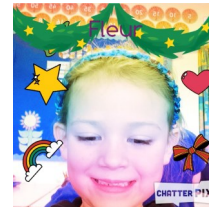

Halloween Costumes and Christmas Jumpers

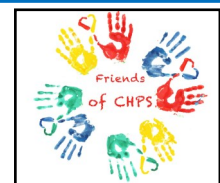


As we approach this time of year you may notice that your child has grown out of last years Halloween or Christmas clothes.
