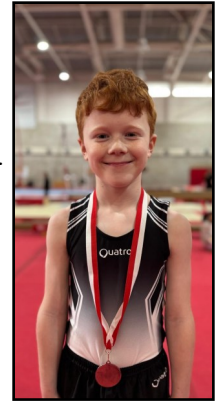

Please do not bring your dogs onto the school site when you are collecting your child from school or from Faraday.

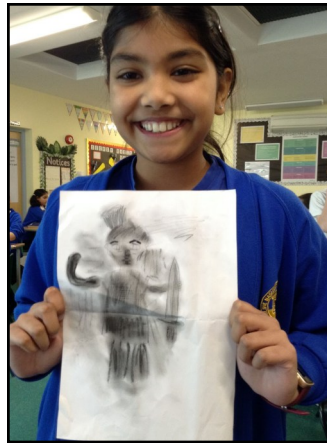
Miss Frankish's Fridge
