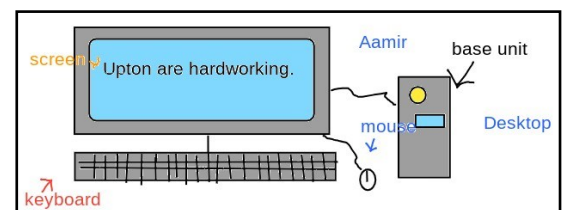
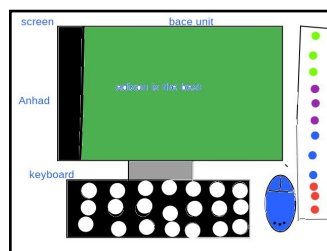
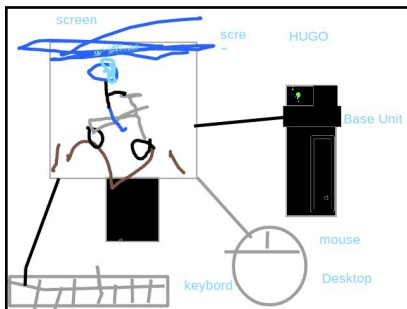
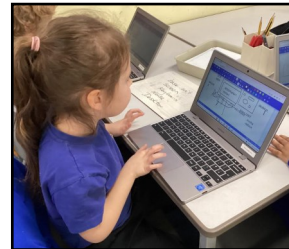
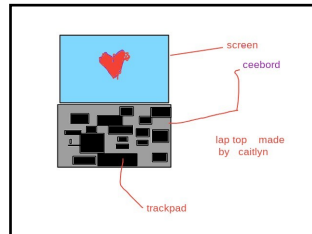
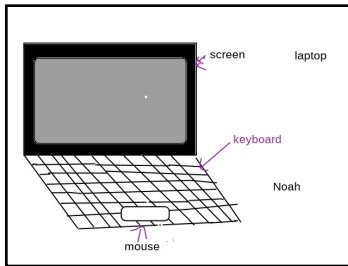
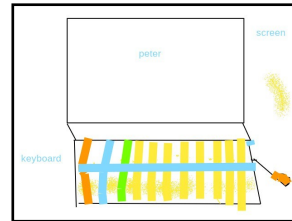


Computing Year 1
