Learning Behaviours

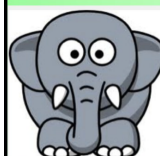
At Caroline Haslett Primary School, we have 8 characters that help us remember the skills of an effective learner in all of our lessons.

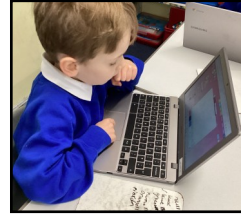
STEM Club

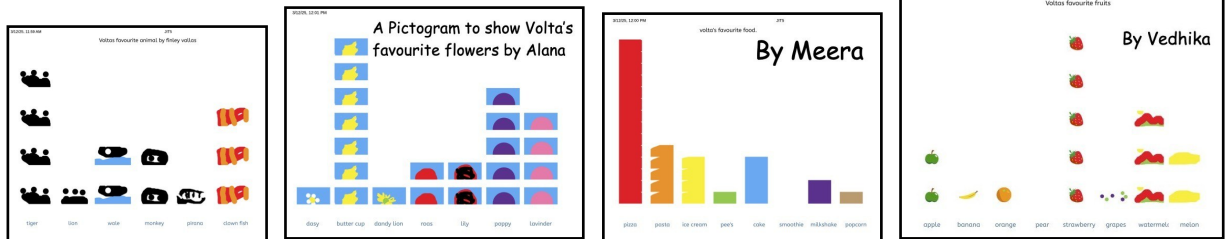
Computing

This half term has been an interesting one for Year 4 as they have dived into Hyper-text Mark-up Language for the first time. The children have explored the concept of HTML tags and elements. Armed with their newfound knowledge, the children opened their Realtime HTML text editors, ready to write their first lines of code. They have carefully crafted HTML structures, experimenting with headings, paragraphs, underlines, backgrounds coloured writing, font styles and many more. Each line of code was a step closer to understanding the language that powers the websites they visit daily. Year 4 tested their knowledge using w3schools exercises. We are looking forward to adding images to our HTML and altering HTML to create fake websites.

Artwork on the Fridge

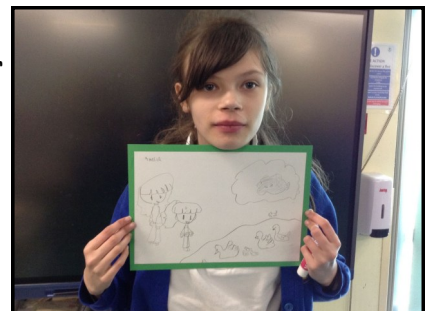
