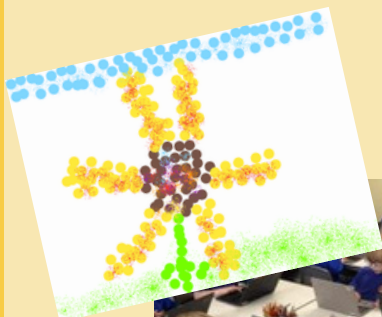

VOCABULARY

brush size	number on the side of the brush refers to the thickness, length, or width of the brush hair.
fill tool	used to fill a selected object, area, or layer with color
line tool	allows you to draw a two-point line on the canvas.
pointillism	a technique of painting described in which small distinct dots of colour are applied to the page.
primary colours	any of a group of colours from which all other colours can be obtained by mixing.
save	Keep and store a file for future use.
shape tool	allows creation of rectangles, circles and other shapes.
undo	a feature of a computer program that allows a user to cancel or reverse the last command.

Digital painting programs such as Paintz App provide freehand tools for painting and drawing.

A digital painting is when you use a PC device, such as a desktop computer, laptop or tablet, to create a picture.

Painting software is a program on a desktop computer, laptop or tablet which lets you create a digital painting.
