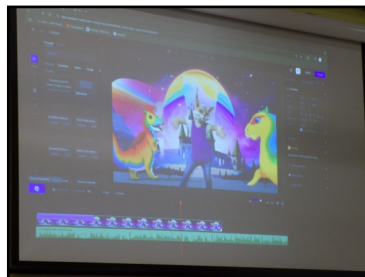
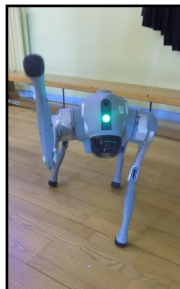


## STEM Roadshow
