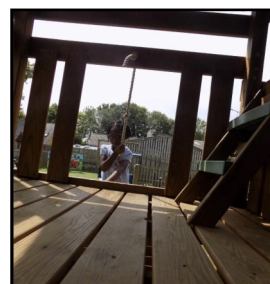


Aston and Pelton Classes Visit Rookery Farm!

It was a day full of laughter, learning, and unforgettable memories. Well done, Aston and Pelton — what a wonderful experience!

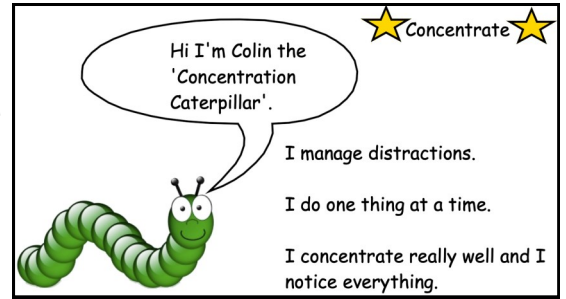


Learning Behaviours

A big well done to everyone involved. We're already looking forward to next year's rounders league!

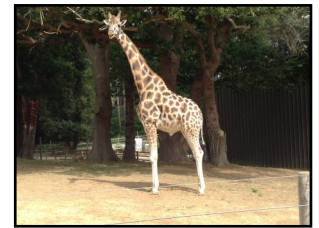


Woburn Safari Park

Well done every single committee member who pulled this together behind the scenes giving up their evenings in the run up and then soldiering through the heat on the day.

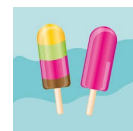
