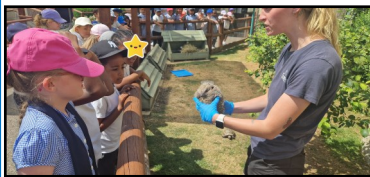


Year 2

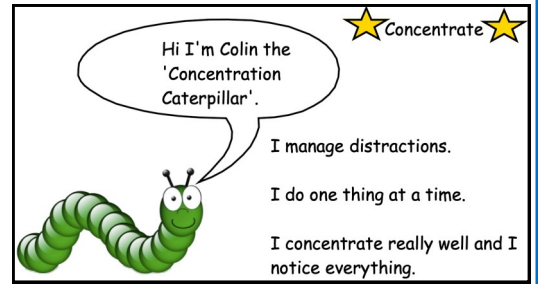


Learning Behaviours

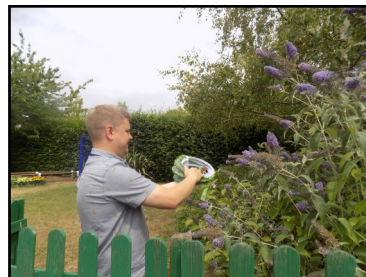


Foundation Stage Life Cycle Learning

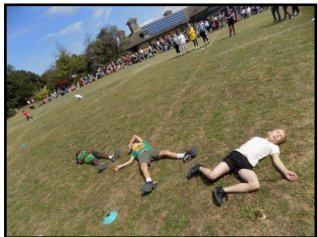
Cakes!
