Aaria from Maybach class performed the song 'The Saints' during a special piano concert on Friday, 04Jul2025.

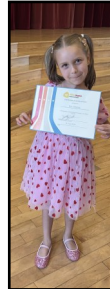
Aaria has been learning Piano with Music Academy Milton Keynes for almost a year and will soon be appearing for her exam as well.

At Caroline Haslett Primary School, we have 8 characters that help us remember the skills of an effective learner in all of our lessons.

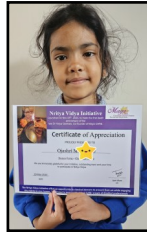
Next week's character will be Charlie the Co-operative Camel. Encourage your child to practise the skills listed below and be like Charlie.

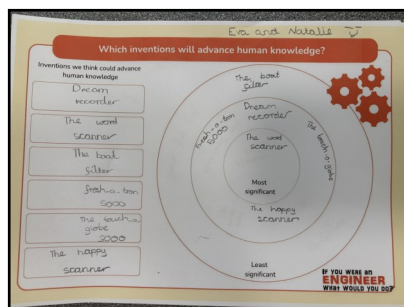
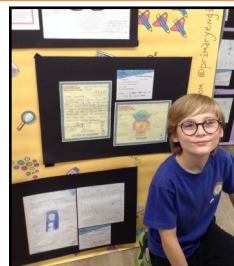
## STEM Club
