Zidane from Pelton class has passed his stage 1 swimming and has now moved up to stage 2. Well done Zidane!



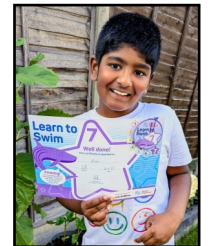
