At Caroline Haslett Primary School, we have 8 characters that help us remember the skills of an effective learner in all of our lessons.

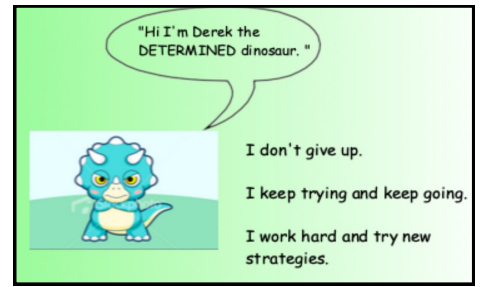
Next week, our character will be Derek the Determined Dinosaur.

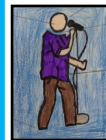

Ojashri from Edison class received her grading in Martial Arts and she got her yellow belt in kickboxing!

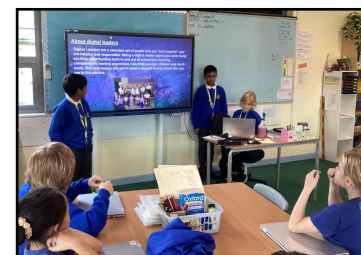

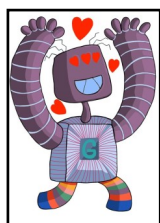
Each house has an Online Safety character which represents a different area of online safety and were designed by Caroline Haslett School children:
