Well done girls!



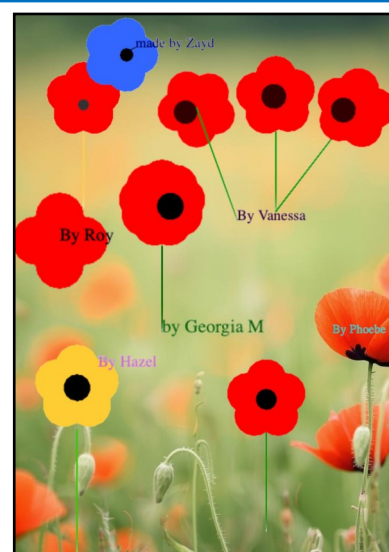
Food Explorers Breakfast Club
