It was a fun and engaging experience for everyone – well done, Year 5!

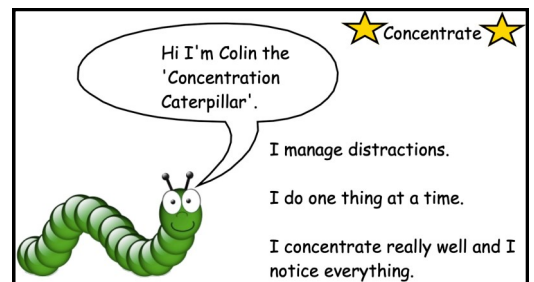


Learning Behaviours
