Well done Yacin!



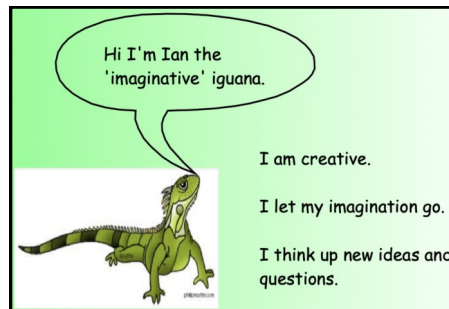
Learning Behaviours

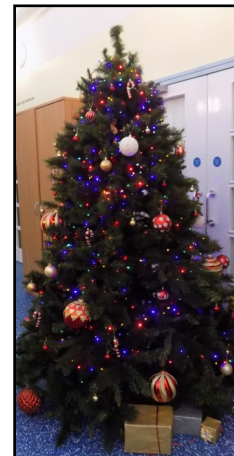

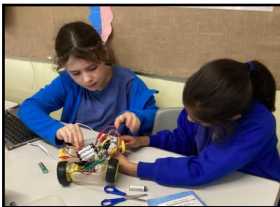
