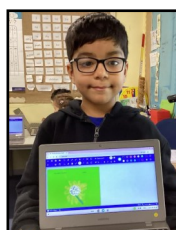
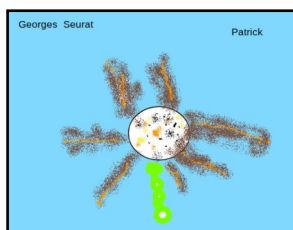
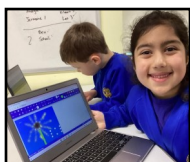
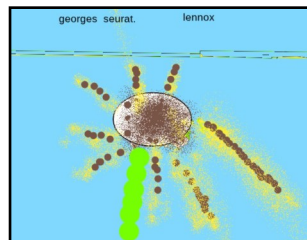
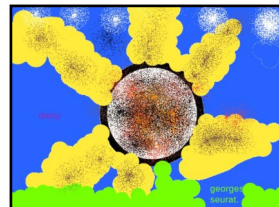
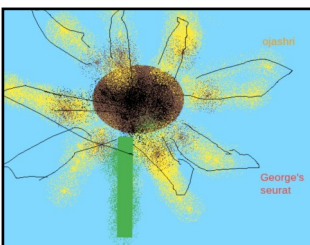
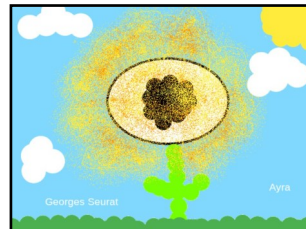
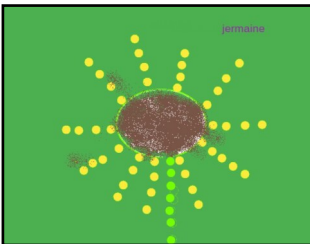
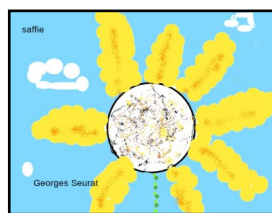
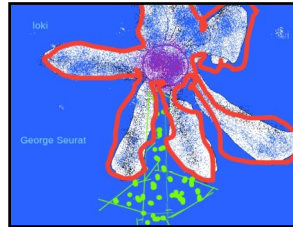
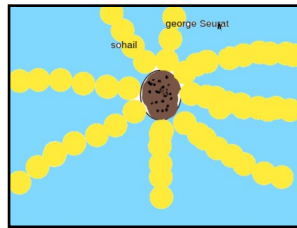
Computing - STEM Club

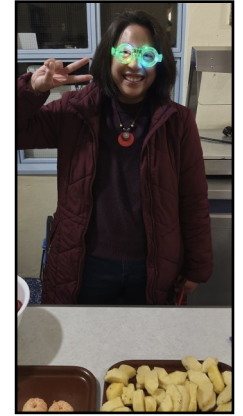
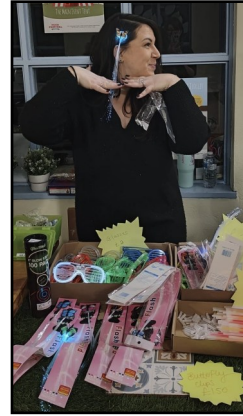
