Online Safety Byte

Combat Online Bullying According to Ofcom's 2022 Media Use and Attitudes report, children are now more likely to be bullied via technology than they are to experience it in person. An alarming 84% of 8 to 17-year-olds who reported being targeted said it had taken place via messaging, social media, online gaming and so on, as opposed to 61% who had been intimidated face-to-face. Here's CHPS's advice if your child is a victim of online bullying

- Make yourself available.
- Be prepared to listen
- Empower your child (delete the app, block the person etc)
- Report to the Website or App.
