The day kicked off with two assemblies presented by our Year 5 Digital Leaders designed to explain about AI and how we can stay safe when using it.

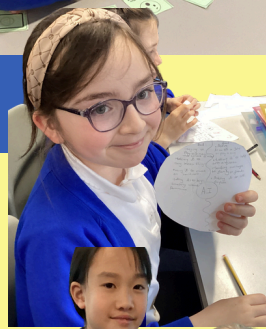


# Caroline Haslett's Safer Internet Day 2026
