## Pupil Achievement

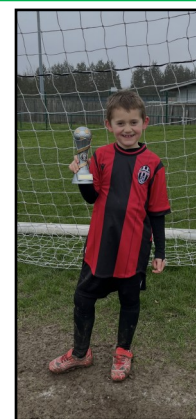

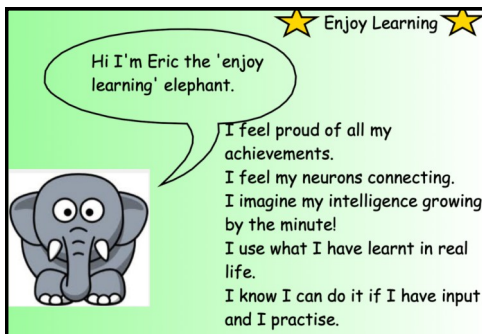


## Learning Behaviours
