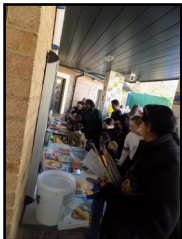

Book Pop Up

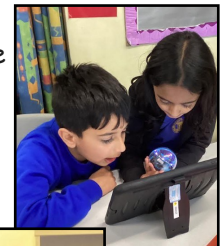
Thank you to all the families who supported yesterday's pop-up book shop. The event was buzzing with excitement, and we loved seeing the children so happy with their book choices.

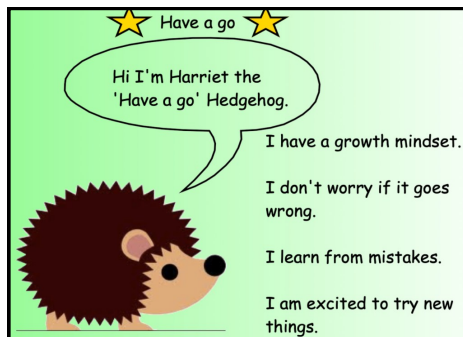


Learning Behaviours
